Titusville is the neighbor to the Kennedy Space Center Visitor Complex, Merritt Island National Wildlife Refuge and Canaveral National Seashore. Titusville is the only place on the planet where space shuttles blast off, sea turtles rest and soothing sunrises give way to inviting surf. The contradiction of high-tech wonders of the space program and the natural beauty of the area places Titusville in a class by itself.

The Titusville area is unique, with three very distinct ecological environments. The area offers endless opportunities for nature lovers. Do not be surprised, you may see a red-tailed hawk or a bald eagle taking in the view with you. In addition to the waterways you will find five golf courses and lots of nostalgic and interesting shops.

You might wonder why the words “Blast-Off” are used in the rally title. Well, here is the story. MISSION STS-131 Space Shuttle Discovery has a launch scheduled for March 18, 2010 from Launch Pad 39A. Space shuttle Discovery will carry a Multi-Purpose Logistics Module filled with science racks that will be transferred to laboratories of the International Space Station. We all know that these launch dates are often pushed back. So, there is a possibility that we will be in the right place at the right time to see a space shuttle lift off!!

A highlight of our rally will be the time that we spend at Kennedy Space Center. We will take an up to the minute look at the gateway to space exploration that has taken place over the last 50 years. We'll ride the grounds and experience the journey of the pioneers of space exploration. As we visit the home of America's Space Shuttle, the last place on earth for International Space Station hardware, we will also roam the historic trails of Mercury, Gemini and Apollo. Look at the agenda for the special plans that have been made for our group. Here, the sky is not the limit – it is just the beginning.



Hubble Telescope

Our home base for the rally is actually a destination in itself. The rally location is The Great Outdoors RV Nature & Golf Resort, America's top-rated RV Resort on Florida's Space Coast – 125 Plantation Drive, Titusville, FL 32780. We have reserved 40 deluxe RV sites with level concrete pads and all utilities including water, 50-amp electricity, cable TV, telephone and sewer. The average size of the sites is 40' x 80'. This luxury venue includes miles of natural walking trails, an 18-hole championship PGA golf course, two heated swimming pools with spas, tennis and shuffleboard courts, horseshoes, lake fishing and much more. There is also a full-service bank and ATM, U.S. Post Office, two restaurants including Plantation House – a fine dining restaurant, hair and nail salon and golf cart rental. At Noon we are scheduled to have LUNCH WITH AN ASTRONAUNT. You will enjoy a delicious full buffet meal followed by a presentation and autograph signing by the astronaut. Fewer than 500 men and women – of the Earth's six billion people – have ever flown in space. You will enjoy a rare opportunity to meet a veteran astronaut.

Then view exhibits for a short time more before departure back to RV Resort.

You will have time upon return to Great Outdoors RV Resort for a brief respite prior to a wine and cheese party, which will be served at the Resort's Plantation Manor.

Thursday, March 25th

Today, luxury coaches will take us to breakfast, followed by a return trip to the Kennedy Space Center. You will be able to continue your exploration of the many attractions at the Visitor Complex.

You will also be able to go on the GENERAL BUS TOUR – Kennedy Space Center Tour.

These buses make 3 stops daily between 10am and 4pm:

1. International Space Station Center
 - This fascinating attraction gives you an up-close glimpse inside the actual facility where NASA prepares the real components of the International Space Station – the largest, most complex structure ever to be placed into orbit.

2. LC Observation Gantry
 - The 60-foot-tall Launch Complex (LC) 39 Observation Gantry provides a breathtaking 360-degree view of the two giant Shuttle Launch Pads, 39A and 39B. You will also experience behind-the-scenes briefings on what it takes to launch and land every NASA Space Shuttle.

3. Apollo/Saturn V Center

The Apollo/Saturn V Center is a tribute to the Apollo astronauts and the machines that got them there, allowed us to watch a single man step onto the moon's surface and then brought them home safely.

We will also make a stop at the United States Astronaut Hall of Fame, where we will experience exhibits dedicated to our nation's astronauts, including the world's largest collection of personal memorabilia and realistic astronaut training simulators.

We will arrive back at the RV resort late afternoon and the balance of the day will be free.

Friday, March 26th

Today is a good day to take in some of the other area activities. You will be provided with lots of information.

Tonight, get ready for our Finalé Dinner Celebration to be held in a private room at the world famous Dixie Crossroads Seafood Restaurant.

Saturday, March 27th

Say good-byes. Hope your experience was "out of this world."

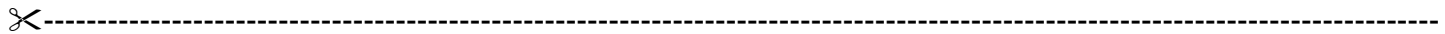
